

Gronvang Region

Gronvang is a small town of about 1500 people, and a thriving farming community. It is ruled lightly by Squire Edgar Gronvang, whose family founded the town several centuries ago. It does a thriving business with Runcibor, about 20 miles to the east, and also provides foodstuffs to Dunor City via a small (but growing) port to the west. The main free farmer families are Gustav Schelmein, a careful man but given to complaining a lot (especially about the cold weather); Hermann Bertolt, a miller and tollkeeper on the ford over the fast flowing Drunstorm River, a parsimonious man who hates paying his taxes on time, and the one real thorn in Squire's side; Frederick Hannis, the region's major miller, a fat, jolly and generous man, excellent at his trade; and Thilde Dogteig, an emotionally labile man, but very humorous, and an excellent draftsman. Further south is the large steading of the Stadtacht family, who cut lumber from the Strumvang Forest, and who resent the 'little bit extra' that Hermann Bertolt adds to the toll to Gronvang.

Elsewhere is the ruin of a Temple of the long-gone (?really) Ardelor elves. In the east is a large stone field with fantastically weathered boulders, one sitting on top of the other. North of the Stadtacht Steading is a cluster of statues of what appears to be Elven soldiers, but a number have fallen over.
