

After the original Lake-town was burned to the waterline during a dragon-fire attack the new settlement was re-built approximately 5 miles to the north of the original site. Its is a man-made island of timbers driven into the lake bottom and at roughly 45 acres is it roughly 3 times the size of the original town. It is divided into districts and quarters based on the facets of local life Folks like and work here, & travelers arrive in Lake-town aboard trading ships and rafts, bringing wares and goods for sale at the markets of the city.
